SENATE BILL 1633

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; stating legislative findings and intent; directing an increase in salary for employees of the Office of Juvenile Affairs; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

A. The Legislature finds that the agency turnover for the Office of Juvenile Affairs is exceedingly high. The Legislature further finds that this agency turnover is a result of uncompetitive salaries among employees of the Office of Juvenile Affairs. It is the intent of the Legislature to improve employee salaries for the Office of Juvenile Affairs to decrease agency turnover.

B. Subject to the appropriation of funds, the salaries for classified employees of the Office of Juvenile Affairs shall increase by the difference between each such employee's pay band midpoint and the hiring rate, or \$3,200 annually, whichever is greater.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
