SENATE BILL 1685

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to bridges, roads and highways; requiring Department of Transportation to prepare report prioritizing bridges, roads and highways for maintenance and repairs; providing for non-codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

No later than December 1, 2006, the Department of Transportation shall provide a report reviewing the age and condition of all bridges, roads and highways in this state and rank in order of priority all maintenance and repair needs for such bridges, roads and highways. Such report shall be delivered upon completion to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma State Senate, the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives and the Secretary of Transportation.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
