SENATE BILL 1713

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to controlled substances; criminalizing the import, transportation or storage of certain substances; stating penalty; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-419.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

It is unlawful for any person to knowingly import, export or transport methamphetamine with intent to illegally distribute such substance, or knowingly store methamphetamine with intent to illegally transport or distribute such substance, or knowingly cause, facilitate, encourage, aid, abet or participate in the import, transportation or storage of methamphetamine intended for illegal distribution in any place, or knowingly provide, import, transport or store any substance or material intended for use in the illegal transportation, manufacture or distribution of methamphetamine. Any person convicted of any violation of this section shall be punished by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than Twenty (20) years, or by a fine in an amount not exceeding One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

For purposes of this section, "methamphetamine" means one pound or more of a mixture containing any detectable quantity of methamphetamine.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
