SENATE BILL 1756

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to children; requiring certain information to be included on the judgment and sentence of certain persons under certain circumstance; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7306-2.10a of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

When committing a person who is, or has been, certified as a youthful offender and is certified eligible for the imposition as an adult sentence pursuant to Section 7306-2.8 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or certified as a youthful offender and is being bridged or transferred to the Department of Corrections for custody or supervision pursuant to Section 7306-2.10 of Title 10 of the Oklahoma Statutes, or sentenced as an adult after previously being certified as a youthful offender, the judgment and sentence shall clearly identify such person as a youthful offender, or previous youthful offender, and detail the history of the applications of the Youthful Offender Act to such person that resulted in the current commitment to the Department of Corrections.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
