SENATE BILL 18

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of State Highway 37 as the "Jason White PASSway"; directing the Department of Transportation to place suitable permanent markers on the highway bearing his name; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 37, located between Mustang and Richland Road in Grady County, shall be designated the "Jason White PASSway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing his name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
