SENATE BILL 1849

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to eminent domain; amending 27 O.S. 2001, Section 5, which relates to certain entities having right to condemn lands for certain purposes; clarifying language; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27 O.S. 2001, Section 5, is amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Any county, ~~city, town, township~~ municipality, school district, or board of education, or any board or official having ~~charge of~~ authority over cemeteries created and existing under the laws of this state, shall have power to condemn lands in like manner as railroad companies, for highways, rights-of-way, building sites, cemeteries, public parks and other public purposes.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
