SENATE BILL 1872

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; requiring municipalities to test certain fire hydrants at certain times; requiring certain agencies to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 108.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1. Every municipal governing body of this state shall, in order to ensure proper functioning, test wet barrel fire hydrants annually, and dry barrel fire hydrants semiannually, no later than March 31 and September 30 of each year.

2. The State Emergency Management Agency or the State Fire Marshal shall promulgate rules which shall include but not be limited to, provisions for certifying and posting the results of such tests.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
