SENATE BILL 1907

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to insurance; requiring coverage for certain prescription drugs; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3634.12 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. For the purposes of this section, "prescription contraceptive drug" means any prescription drug in any form that prevents the union of an ovum with the spermatozoon or the subsequent implantation of the fertilized ovum in the uterus.

B. A health insurance plan or policy or health maintenance organization providing prescription drugs as a covered benefit shall cover prescription contraceptive drugs.

C. Health insurance plans or policies or health maintenance organizations offered by businesses with fifty (50) or fewer employees are exempt from the provisions of this act.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
