SENATE BILL 1925

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring seller of vehicle to retain license plate and to take certain action within specified time period; requiring Oklahoma Tax Commission to promulgate rules; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1113.1 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, upon the sale of any vehicle the seller shall retain the license plate from the vehicle being sold and shall, within thirty (30) days from the date of the sale, either transfer the plate to another vehicle owned by the seller or return the plate to the Oklahoma Tax Commission or one of its motor license agents.

B. The Tax Commission shall promulgate such rules as may be necessary to implement the provisions of subsection A of this section.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
