SENATE BILL 1986

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring State Board of Education to develop fitness testing system; specifying certain component of system; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100b of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Board of Education shall develop a fitness testing system designed to assess the fitness level of each student in the public schools of this state. Such system shall utilize, at a minimum, body mass index screening data.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
