AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to liens; amending 42 O.S. 2001, Section 47, which relates to agricultural lien; updating statutory reference; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 42 O.S. 2001, Section 47, is amended to read as follows:

Section 47. A. Any person selling, furnishing, applying or providing to the owner of crops which are growing or to be grown, any seed, chemicals, pesticides, herbicides or fertilizer for the growing of the crops shall, upon filing, have a lien on the crops for the amount due for such seed, chemicals, pesticides, herbicides or fertilizer or for the application thereof. The lien provided for in this section shall be subject to all prior perfected liens.

B. The lien created by this section shall not be effective unless:

1. Filed as an agricultural lien pursuant to ~~Article 9 of the Uniform Commercial Code~~ Section 1-9-101 et seq. of Title 12A of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

2. Notice is given to the owner of the land on which the crops are growing or to be grown at the time of filing by mailing a copy of the verified statement by certified mail, return receipt requested.

C. The lien created by this section may be foreclosed by the sale of the crops subject to the lien anytime within twelve (12)

months after filing of the lien in accordance with the provisions of Title 12A of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
