SENATE BILL 2051

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to State government; creating the Oklahoma Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2006; providing short title; stating purpose; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 55 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act of 2006".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 55.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each year thousands of undocumented aliens enter this state and nation illegally despite the efforts of the federal government and border control agencies to interdict the flow of illegal immigration. The presence of grievous numbers of low-paid individuals with few resources of their own that are undocumented or are illegally residing in the state of Oklahoma is a considerable burden on the resources of state, county and local human service and law enforcement agencies. As a result the hard-earned tax dollars of legal citizens of this state must be redirected to benefit those who enter this country and state illegally. Therefore, it is the responsibility of the Oklahoma State Legislature and other state, county and local officials to protect the resources and services of the legal citizens of this state. It is imperative that the

Oklahoma State Legislature enact in as expedient a manner as possible the initiatives necessary to achieve the objectives of this act.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
