SENATE BILL 21

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mines and mining; amending 45 O.S. 2001, Section 9.1, which relates to mining with explosives; updating reference to certain agency; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 45 O.S. 2001, Section 9.1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 9.1 It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, individually or in association with others, to establish, open up, commence or carry on any quarrying operation for stone or stone products wherein blasting is required, or to conduct any other quarrying operations for commercial or industrial purposes requiring the use of powder, dynamite, nitroglycerin or other explosives within a minimum distance established by rule ~~or~~ regulation adopted promulgated by the ~~Chief Mine Inspector~~ Oklahoma Mining Commission from any established school, church or other house of worship. This section shall not apply to underground mines or to any quarrying or mining plants already constructed or in actual operation before June 19, 1961.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
