SENATE BILL 258

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 4254, which relates to lobbying; prohibiting certain person from receiving compensation or reimbursement for lobbying for certain time period; prohibiting certain persons from being registered as lobbyist for certain time period; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 4254, is amended to read as follows:

Section 4254. A. No state officer or state employee shall receive any additional compensation or reimbursement from any person for personally engaging in lobbying other than compensation or reimbursements provided by law for that member's job position.

B. No member of the Legislature or elective state officer shall receive any compensation or reimbursement from any person for personally engaging in lobbying for a period of two (2) years after the member's or officer's term of office has expired, nor shall any such member or officer be eligible to register as a lobbyist during such time period.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective January 1, 2006.
