SENATE BILL 281

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to environment and natural resources; amending 27A O.S. 2001, Section 2-10-102, which relates to solid waste management; modifying purpose of certain act to regulate recycling of solid waste; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 27A O.S. 2001, Section 2-10-102, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-10-102. It is the purpose of the Oklahoma Solid Waste Management Act and it is hereby declared to be the policy of this state and its political subdivisions to regulate the collection, transportation, processing, recycling and disposal of solid waste in a manner that will:

1. Protect the public health, safety and welfare;
2. Protect the environment of the state;
3. Conserve valuable land and other natural resources;
4. Enhance the beauty and quality of the environment; and
5. Encourage recycling of solid waste.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
