SENATE BILL 292

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1111, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 368, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 11-1111), which relates to throwing or dropping objects from a bridge or overpass; prohibiting throwing or dropping any substance at a moving vehicle or from a bridge or overpass; removing certain language relating to intent; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-1111, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 368, O.S.L. 2003 (47 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 11-1111), is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-1111. A. No person shall willfully throw or drop any substance at a moving vehicle or any occupant thereof.

~~B. No person shall or willfully throw or drop any object from a bridge or overpass with intent to damage any property or injure any person.~~

~~C. B.~~ Any violation of ~~subsection A or B~~ of this section shall be deemed a felony and, upon conviction, shall be punishable by imprisonment in the Department of Corrections for a term of not more than ten (10) years, or by a fine not exceeding Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
