SENATE BILL 304

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1150.14, which relates to soil tests performed by certain state employees; removing prohibition for certain employees to perform certain soil tests for compensation; stating requirements; providing restrictions; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 1150.14, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1150.14 Individuals registered under the Oklahoma Sanitarian and Environmental Specialist Registration Act who are employed by the State of Oklahoma ~~shall not~~ may only perform soil tests to design sewage disposal systems for compensation during hours when they are not officially on work status as a state employee, as defined by a state agency's policy and procedures.

This section shall not preclude the State of Oklahoma from receiving compensation for soil tests performed by these individuals as part of their official state employment duties.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
