AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to mines and mining; amending 45 O.S. 2001, Section 1g, which relates to certain regulation by the Department of Environmental Quality; updating statutory references; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 45 O.S. 2001, Section 1g, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1g. Any point source discharge, the disposal of any hazardous waste, as regulated by the Oklahoma Hazardous Waste Management Act, Section 2-7-101 et seq. of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, or solid waste, sewage or other wastewater, and any air emission subject to the Oklahoma Clean Air Act, Section 2-5-101 et seq. of Title 27A of the Oklahoma Statutes, from any mine or mining activity shall be regulated by the Department of Environmental Quality.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
