SENATE BILL 307

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 4218, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 393, O.S.L. 2003 (63 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 4218), which relates to the Oklahoma Boating Safety Regulation Act; modifying penalties for certain violations; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 4218, as amended by Section 8, Chapter 393, O.S.L. 2003 (63 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 4218), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4218. A. Except as otherwise provided by the provisions of this section, any person violating the provisions of the Oklahoma Boating Safety Regulation Act for which another penalty is not provided, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not to exceed less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) including court costs and fees for each such violation.

B. Any person who violates Section 4213 of this title for which another penalty is not provided, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not less than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and not more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

C. Any person who violates any provision of Sections 4206 through 4212 of this title, for which another penalty is not provided, upon conviction thereof, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00)

~~to exceed~~ nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) including
court costs and fees for each such violation.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
