SENATE BILL 35

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Corporation Commission; providing certain marine fuel facilities shall be subject to certain laws or rules; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 630 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law or rule promulgated by the Corporation Commission, any facility providing marine fuel on any portion of a lake that borders both the State of Oklahoma and the State of Texas shall be subject to the laws or rules of whichever state is less restrictive.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
