SENATE BILL 365

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to agriculture, game and fish and tourism; directing the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation and the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department to cooperate with the United States Department of Agriculture and Rural Development in the development of an agritourism program in the State of Oklahoma; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation, and the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, in cooperation with the United States Department of Agriculture and Rural Development, shall:

1. Provide resources to implement an agritourism program for the State of Oklahoma;
2. Lead the effort to create and develop a sustainable agritourism industry for the State of Oklahoma; and
3. Carry out the intent of the Oklahoma Agritourism Master Plan, developed by the Agritourism Steering Committee.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
