SENATE BILL 523

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; requiring the Department of Transportation to determine uniform size for certain signs by certain date; requiring Department to promulgate certain rules; providing for noncodification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

On or before January 30, 2006, the Department of Transportation shall determine a uniform size for all signs dedicating or memorializing public roads and highways under the administration of the Department. The Department shall promulgate any rules necessary to implement the provisions of this section. Such rules shall be submitted in the 2nd Session of the 50th Oklahoma Legislature in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
