SENATE BILL 569

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring all children to be provided certain identification number by State Department of Education upon entering certain programs; stating purpose; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-161 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon entering any program serving children from birth through entry into kindergarten funded with state or federal public monies, a child shall be provided a permanent student identification number by the State Department of Education's statewide student record system program. The number will be stripped of client-specific identifiers and will be used to conduct program-related and academic research with the specific goal of determining the impact of these preschool programs on school readiness.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
