AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to veterans; requiring the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs to make available specified educational materials to certain persons; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 244 of Title 72, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs shall make available educational materials, in written and electronic forms, on the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of hepatitis C to all veterans, physicians or other health care providers, and other persons at high risk for hepatitis C. Such materials shall include the recommendations of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the United States Department of Health and Human Services, and any other entity having knowledge of hepatitis C, including the American Liver Foundation.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
