SENATE BILL 693

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 78d, which relates to the Fleet Management Division of the Department of Central Services; modifying persons to whom certain statement must be submitted; modifying contents thereof; specifying certain duties of State Auditor and Inspector; requiring certain audit be submitted to certain persons; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 78d, is amended to read as follows:

Section 78d. The Fleet Management Division shall furnish to the Governor and the State Auditor and Inspector at the close of each fiscal year a statement showing the financial condition of the Division, an inventory of all motor vehicles ~~under its control~~ owned by state agencies, and such other information regarding the state motor vehicle transportation system as is necessary for a proper understanding of the operation of such system and of the financial ~~condition of the motor pool operations~~ accounting of the use of and finances relating to all motor vehicles owned by state agencies. The State Auditor and Inspector shall examine such statement and shall annually conduct an audit relating to the use, acquisition or disposition of state-agency-owned vehicles, which shall include, but not be limited to, the State Fleet Management Fund, the disposition of funds from the sale of vehicles pursuant to the Oklahoma Surplus Property Act and any other financial or other records of state agencies relating to the use, acquisition or disposition of state-

agency-owned vehicles. The State Auditor and Inspector shall submit such audit to the Governor, the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
