SENATE BILL 698

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating a portion of State Highway 51 as the "Mannford Expressway"; directing the Department of Transportation to place suitable permanent markers on the highway bearing the designation; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 51, from its intersection with State Highway 97 in Creek County west to its intersection with State Highway 48 in Mannford, Oklahoma, shall be designated as the "Mannford Expressway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the highway bearing the designation.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
