SENATE BILL 767

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations; prohibiting the location of certain medical practices in certain establishments; providing for construction; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 500.1 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. It shall be unlawful for any ophthalmologist to establish a practice location in any individual retail or mercantile establishment which sells merchandise to the general public.

B. For the purposes of this section, a retail mall shall not be considered to be an individual retail or mercantile establishment.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
