SENATE BILL 778

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to poor persons; requiring the Department of Human Services to increase certain reimbursement rate; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 227A of Title 56, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Effective July 1, 2005, the Department of Human Services shall increase reimbursement rates to providers of developmental disabilities services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
