AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to cities and towns; authorizing a municipal governing body to enact certain ordinances; providing for limited publication; authorizing certain person to provide copies for distribution or sale; requiring the municipality to adopt certain building standards as last adopted by the Construction Industries Board; providing for ordinances passed with an emergency clause; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-107.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. If a municipal governing body enacts or adopts by reference ordinances which are compilations or codes of law or regulations relating to plumbing, mechanical and electrical installations, or any other matters which the municipality has the power to regulate, such ordinances are not required to be published in full. Legal publication of such ordinances may be by publishing the title and a summary of their contents as provided by Section 14-106 of this title. At least one copy of such ordinances shall be kept in the office of the municipal clerk for public use, inspection, and examination. The municipal clerk shall keep copies of the ordinances, codes, or compilations for distribution or sale at a reasonable price.

B. A municipality which adopts building standards shall adopt and enforce the building code as last adopted by the Construction Industries Board.

C. Ordinances which are passed by the governing body with an emergency clause attached are not required to be published in full, but may be published by title only in the manner provided by Section 14-106 of this title.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
