SENATE BILL 929

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to telephone solicitations; requiring certain entities to use certain persons within certain county; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 140.10 of Title 17, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Any charitable or non-profit organization or entity otherwise authorized by law to solicit any person by telephone on behalf of the organization shall be required to have at least one member or employee residing within the county where the call is received.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
