SENATE BILL 963

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to crimes and punishments; amending 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1578, which relates to possession of forged evidence of debt; modifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1578, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1578. Every person who, with intent to defraud, has in ~~his~~ their possession any forged, altered or counterfeit negotiable note, bill, draft or other evidence of debt issued or purporting to have been issued by any corporation or company duly authorized for that purpose by the laws of this state or of any other state, government or country, the forgery of which is hereinbefore declared to be punishable, knowing the same to be forged, altered or counterfeited, with intent to utter the same as true or as false, or to cause the same to be so uttered, is guilty of forgery in the second degree.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
