SENATE BILL 969

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health insurance; requiring the Insurance Commissioner to implement certain Internet-based information clearinghouse; specifying types of information; stating purpose; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 307.3 of Title 36, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

On or before January 1, 2006, the Insurance Commissioner shall create an Internet-based information clearinghouse as provided in this section. The information clearinghouse shall provide information concerning all health insurance plans licensed to do business in this state and information concerning the products offered by such plans. The purpose of this section is to aid Oklahoma-based small businesses in the pursuit of finding suitable and affordable health insurance products.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
