SENATE BILL 971

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to workers' compensation; exempting certain persons from application of the Workers' Compensation Act; providing exception; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2.8 of Title 85, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Workers' Compensation Act shall not apply to any person who is providing physician services by contract with or on behalf of a county health department for a medical care program administered by the State Department of Health, unless the Department is required by federal law or regulations to provide workers' compensation coverage for such person.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.

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
