SENATE BILL 982

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-115, which relates to administration of public school system in Oklahoma; updating title of certain office; deleting obsolete language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 1-115, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1-115. The public school system in Oklahoma shall be administered by the State Department of Education, ~~State Superintendent of Schools county superintendents of schools, the~~ State Superintendent of Public Instruction, boards of education of school districts, and superintendents of schools of independent school districts.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
