AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3010, which relates to sheltered workshops; clarifying language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3010, is amended to read as follows:

Section 3010. Any municipality or county agency of this state is hereby authorized to purchase products and services from any qualified nonprofit agency providing employment to persons with severe disabilities which is certified as a sheltered workshop by the Wage and Hour Division of the United States Department of Labor. Procurements made pursuant to the provisions of this section shall not be subject to competitive bid requirements. To participate, a qualified nonprofit agency for the severely disabled must be able to meet the needs and specifications for the products or services required by the purchasing body at a fair market price.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
