RESOLUTION 33

AS INTRODUCED

A Joint Resolution disapproving amendments to certain Rules of the Ethics Commission; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2005, pursuant to its authority under Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, the Ethics Commission promulgated amendments to its Rules, as codified in the Appendix to Chapter 62 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on February 7, 2005, the Ethics Commission submitted its proposed rule changes to the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections C and D of Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, the Legislature may, by joint resolution, disapprove any rules or modification of rules promulgated by the Ethics Commission during the legislative session in which they are submitted; and

WHEREAS, the Legislature recognizes that the 2005 proposed amendments to Rules 257:10-1-1 and 257:10-1-9 of the Rules of the Ethics Commission are not consistent with legislative intent and the public policy of this state, and are not in the best interests of the citizens of Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. The proposed amendments to Rules 257:10-1-1 and 257:10-1-9 of the Rules of the Ethics Commission , as codified in

the Appendix to Chapter 62 of Title 74 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and as submitted to the Legislature on February 7, 2005, are hereby disapproved.

SECTION 2. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Executive Director and members of the Ethics Commission.
