AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Pawnee High School Black Bears football team for their undefeated season; congratulating them upon winning the Class A state championship; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Pawnee High School Black Bears football team was Class 2A runner-up two seasons ago; and

WHEREAS, the 2004 Pawnee High School Black Bears football team achieved an undefeated regular season, enabling them to compete in the state Class A playoffs; and

WHEREAS, after defeating the Tonkawa Buccaneers 35-7 in the District A-6 regional, the Pawnee Black Bears trailed 7-0 at the end of the first quarter and were tied 7-7 at the half before defeating the Beaver Dusters 29-7 in the Class A semi-final game to acquire a slot in the Class A state championship game; and

WHEREAS, before the championship game, the undefeated Black Bears football team was scoring an average of more than 50 points per game while allowing an average of under 15 points to be scored against them; and

WHEREAS, in the championship football game at Sullins Stadium, the Pawnee Black Bears overpowered the Tonkawa Buccaneers 31-14, retaining their unbeaten season, defeating the Bucs for the second time that year, and winning their first-ever Class A State Championship.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the 2004 unbeaten Pawnee High School Black Bears football team for their perfect 15-0 season.
