AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Frontier High School Mustangs boys and girls basketball teams for winning the Class A Championship; congratulating them for being only the fifth high school to win both the boys and girls championship in the same year; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the Frontier High School Mustangs boys basketball team has participated in every state championship tournament for the last eleven years, played in the last three title games, and won the last two including the 2005 Class A Championship. It was the first-ranked team all season for the past two seasons and is expected to repeat next year finishing this year with a 27-3 record; and

WHEREAS, the Frontier High School Mustangs girls basketball team has played in the last three Class A Championship games and won two, including the 2005 Class A Championship at the State Fair Arena; and

WHEREAS, according to "The Oklahoman" Frontier High School is just the fifth to win both a girls and boys state title in the same year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Frontier High School Mustangs for winning the Boys Class A Basketball championship and the Girls Class A Basketball Championship.

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates the Frontier High School Mustangs basketball teams for winning both the boys and girls

state title in the same year, becoming only the fifth school to achieve this honor.
