AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Perry High School Maroons wrestling team for earning their 32nd State Championship title, the 2005 Class 2A Dual State Championship, and the 2005 Academic State Championship title; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, on Saturday, February 12, 2005, at the Tulsa Union Multipurpose Activity Center, the Perry High School Maroons wrestling team avenged an earlier loss to Pawhuska to win 31-30 in the final of Class 2A Dual State Championship.
