AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution expressing gratitude to Senator Angela Monson for her service in the Oklahoma State Senate; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Angela Monson is completing her twelfth year of service to the citizens of Senate District 48 in the Oklahoma State Senate; and

WHEREAS, Angela Monson was born in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, on July 31, 1955, the daughter of Herman Monson Sr. and Reverend Epron Provo Monson. She received her bachelor's degree from Oklahoma City University and a Masters of Public Administration from the University of Oklahoma. She served as Executive Director of the Oklahoma Health Care Project, was a Circuit Riding City Manager for six small rural communities, and was Federal Funds Coordinator and Analyst for the Oklahoma State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, Angela Monson was elected to the Oklahoma State Senate in 1993, having previously been elected to the Oklahoma State House of Representatives in 1990 and 1992. Senator Monson served as President of the National Conference of State Legislatures, on the Executive Committee of the National Black Caucus of State Legislators, as well as National Advisory Council Chair of the National Health Services Corps. Senator Monson currently serves as Assistant Majority Leader and chairs the Education Committee; and

WHEREAS, State Question 632, adopted September 18, 1990, and effective January 1, 1991, limits the length of service for members of the Legislature to a total of 12 years, and as a result thereof,

Senator Angela Monson will be relinquishing her State Senate seat in November of this year; and

WHEREAS, Senator Angela Monson has made her mark on the Oklahoma State Senate with her dedication to the health and welfare of the forgotten and needy of this state, a strong belief in civil rights, and her devotion to her children.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate on behalf of the citizens of Senate District 48 and all the citizens of this state, expresses its gratitude to Senator Angela Monson for her service in the Oklahoma State Senate.
