AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Silo High School Rebels baseball team for winning the Class A state championship; congratulating Coach Billy Jack Bowen for coaching his seventh championship team; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Silo High School in Durant, Oklahoma, has had a tradition of winning baseball. The team was state runner-up in 2004. The high school Rebels from Bryan County have also demonstrated resiliency this season by winning a number of very close games; and

WHEREAS, the Silo High School Rebels won their second state title in the past four years by defeating the Rock Creek Mustangs 11-10 in the 2005 Class A baseball championship game at Dolese Park. The Rebels also won the Bryan County tournament title, ending their season with a 39-2 record; and

WHEREAS, according to "Oklahoma High School Sports Magazine", Billy Jack Bowen won his sixth spring baseball title as coach, placing him in a tie with two other Oklahoma coaches for the fifth-most, all-time wins.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate commends the Silo High School Rebels baseball team for winning the 2005 Class A state championship, their second in four years.
