AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Coalgate public schools girls track and field team for winning the Class 3A state championship; congratulating the Lady Cats for winning their second consecutive championship; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, in May 2004, at Mustang, Oklahoma, the Coalgate girls Lady Cats track and field team won its first state meet with 107 points, and

WHEREAS, in May 2005, at Moore, Oklahoma, the Coalgate girls Lady Cats track and field team won its second consecutive Class 3A state championship with 99 points; and

WHEREAS, Coalgate's Teran Mixon set the state meet record in the 800 meter run, running the distance in 2:14.90, according to "The Oklahoman" newspaper. Constance Thompson also set the state pole vault meet record with 11 feet 0 inches.
