AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending the Oklahoma Christian Academy boys and girls track team and Lady Eagles basketball team for winning state championships; congratulating the school for its winning record; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Christian Academy (OCA), in Edmond, Oklahoma, is a private Christian school for Pre-K4 through twelfth grade students. The general mission of Oklahoma Christian Academy is to assist the family and the Church in providing God-centered Christian education. The undergirding purpose of Oklahoma Christian Academy is to teach young people in a Christian environment; and

WHEREAS, on Saturday, May 7, 2005, Oklahoma Christian Academy won the Oklahoma Christian School Athletic 3A state track meet in Shawnee, Oklahoma. Both the boys and girls won team titles as the Eagles and Lady Eagles won 11 combined events. This is the second straight state 3A championship for the girls, who won the meet last season as well as six events this year. Last year the boys came in in third place; and

WHEREAS, the Lady Eagles basketball team won the private-school championship. It was their second straight state championship and the fifth straight season the team played in the title game.
