AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution commending Lindsey Williams; congratulating her upon her selection as 2006 America's Miss National Teenager; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, America's National Teenager Scholarship Organization was founded more than 35 years ago to recognize outstanding young women throughout the country and help them reach their educational goals. America's National Teenager Scholarship Organization promotes academics and community service. Scholarships are awarded to winners on both state and national levels based on scholastic achievement, community involvement, leadership qualities, and communications skills. Teens from across the nation vie for top honors in events ranging from academic achievement, interview, poise and personality, and personal expression; and

WHEREAS, Lindsey Williams, a 17-year-old from Sapulpa, Oklahoma, is a four-year member of the National Honor Society, the 2003 Oklahoma Delegate to the National Congressional Student Leadership Conference, and has been awarded over \$150,000 in national scholarships. Her community service in more than ten programs includes Girl Power, Drug Free Youth, Children's Miracle Network Telethon, Pregnancy Prevention Panel, mentoring and reading at elementary and middle schools, and Meals on Wheels. She is a sports trainer for her high school football team, played the lead roles in several theater productions, is a school Advanced and Jazz Choir member, class officer, and prom coordinator. She is listed in

"Who's Who Among America's High School Students". Her professional ambition is to obtain a degree in dentistry; and

WHEREAS, Lindsey Williams, after eight days of competition in Nashville, Tennessee, was crowned 2006 America's Miss National Teenager. She was awarded a \$10,000 cash scholarship, a personal computer, a full four-year scholarship to Oklahoma City University, a trip to the Miss America Pageant, and a personal appearance contract that will take her across the country during the next year.
