AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution congratulating the East Central High School Cardinals for winning the Class 5A State Football Championship; commending their winning season and first state title; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, the East Central High School Cardinals football team of Tulsa, Oklahoma, had gone to the playoff but lost in the semifinals in the previous two seasons; and

WHEREAS, the East Central High School Cardinals football team won the State Class 5A title by defeating Bixby 9-7 in a defensive battle that wasn't decided until the last seconds of the game; and

WHEREAS, on National Signing Day, Oklahoma's Class 5A State Football Champions, the East Central High School Cardinals, had ten student-athletes signed to play college football, more than any other Tulsa, Oklahoma, high school.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma State Senate congratulates East Central High School Cardinals football team for winning the Class 5A State Football Championship.
