AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution congratulating the Putnam City High School Pirates Boys Basketball team upon winning the 2006 Class 6A Basketball State Championship; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, at the March 2006 Class 6A Boys Basketball State tournament, the Putnam City High School Pirates, ranked second in the state, defeated the first-ranked Edmond Santa Fe Wolves, 64-44, and then in the final game defeated the eighth-ranked Tulsa Union Redskins, 58-42, at the Maybee Center in Tulsa, Oklahoma. Before a crowd of 4,500, the two teams contended for the third time in five years; and

WHEREAS, the Putnam City Pirates won the Class 6A Boys Basketball State Championship in 2002 and were participating in their fifth state tournament in the last six years.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 50TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
