An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 197.2, which relates to the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act; providing certain increase to minimum wage amount; and providing an effective date.

**HB 1225** – By Shelton.

An Act relating to labor; amending 40 O.S. 2001, Section 197.2, which relates to the Oklahoma Minimum Wage Act; providing certain increases to minimum wage amount; and providing an effective date.

qualified rural housing assets; defining term; specifying deduction percentage; requiring location of rural housing assets in certain areas for eligibility; authorizing tax credits; providing for credits issued to certain qualified initial recipient; providing for transferability of credits; specifying credit amount based on certain completed units of output; limiting total amount of credits; defining terms; prescribing procedures for use of credits; requiring certain information to be provided to Oklahoma Tax Commission; imposing restriction upon discount of credits; providing limitation upon time period for use of credit; imposing duties upon Oklahoma Tax Commission; providing for certification process; providing for inapplicability of certain sales tax exemption; requiring payment of applicable sales tax on certain purchases for manufacture of certain components; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

An Act relating to revenue and taxation; authorizing income tax credit for certain equity investment in qualified agricultural processing business; defining terms; specifying amount of credit; prohibiting use of credit in conjunction with certain credits; requiring notification to Tax Commission regarding proposed use of credit; providing credit inapplicable to certain invested amount; specifying percentage of credit applicable for designated taxable years; providing for reduction of credit percentage for certain taxable years; requiring capital investment of invested funds within particular period of time; prohibiting special allocation of tax credit; prohibiting use of credit to reduce liability to less than certain amount; authorizing carryover; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

Supp. 2005, Section 2887), which relates to ad valorem tax exemptions; modifying exemption for continuum of care retirement community; and providing an effective date.

Supp. 2005, Sections 1140 and 1141.1), which relate to motor license agents; placing motor license agents under supervision of the Department of Public Safety under certain circumstances; adding fee for motor license agents; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
