**REMARKS**

Representative Toure addressed the House as a term-limited Member. Upon unanimous consent request of Representative Lindley, the remarks of Representative Toure were ordered printed in full as follows:

“On February 14, 1994, I received the Oath of Office to serve as State Representative for House District 99. I have been re-elected six times. It has been an honor, pleasure, and a blessing to serve in this Chamber. I shall be forever grateful to the people of District 99 for placing their trust in me.

I shall always be grateful to my co-worker of 10 years – Tilly Thomas.

I have mixed emotions today. The year I began campaigning for office, my sole living grandmother died, my father was murdered and my great aunt died – all within a four-month period. During my third term, my youngest brother was murdered. On Sunday, my first campaign treasurer, my fishing buddy, my Deacon, my confidant, my brother, Vernon Rider, died in an automobile collision.

Let me thank all of you who have been praying for my family and me.

On February 14, 1994, I came to this Chamber with some deep convictions. I believed that our state was sending too many people to prison unnecessarily; that we needed more effective means of punishment, and that we should concentrate our efforts on helping our children realize their dreams rather than sending them to prison for the rest of their lives.

I believed that all forms of discrimination based on race, gender, and sexual orientation should be eliminated.

I believed in the rights of labor.

I believed in quality education for all children.

I believed that Langston University must receive equity.

And, I believed that the death penalty should be abolished.

Over the years, I have gained much. I now have two grandchildren. I don't move as fast as I used to move. I know much more than I did on February 14, 1994. I have more friends than I did on February 14, 1994.

And yet, I still believe that our state sends too many people to prison unnecessarily; all forms of discrimination based on race, gender and sexual orientation must be eliminated; the rights of labor; a quality education for all children; that Langston University must receive equity; and that the death penalty should be abolished....

Madam Speaker, I am a Democrat – a democrat with a big “D” and a democrat with a little “d.” My Democratic colleagues have supported me as Chairperson of the Committee on Commerce, Industry & Labor, the Judiciary Committee, and as Democratic Floor Leader, and have helped me pass some controversial legislation. Jari, Debbie, Barbara, Abe, Joe, Mike, Bob, I shall be forever grateful.

The journal shall reflect that I experienced both victory and defeat in this Chamber. On occasion, I was knocked down. But some years ago, I took to heart the advice of Winston Churchill – never, never, never, give up. So, Darrell, Al, Richard, Terry, Mike -- never, never, never, give up.

We still have two more days of session. Perhaps I will have a chance to debate one more time. I certainly hope so, for I have one line I never got a chance to use on my colleague Bill Graves. Madame Speaker, there are 2000 totally useless words in the English language. My colleague has somehow found a way in his debate to use every last one of them.

I pray that God grants each of you wisdom, and the desires of your heart.”
