Representative Perry moved that when the clerk's desk is clear, the House of Representatives of the Fiftieth Legislature adjourn sine die, which motion was declared adopted.

The clerk's desk being clear, and as provided in the Perry motion, the House of Representatives of the Second Regular Session of the Fiftieth Legislature at the hour of 4:59 p.m. adjourned sine die.
