9 designating certain highway; requiring placement of
10 markers; providing for codification; and declaring an
11 emergency.

14 AMENDMENT NO. 1. Strike the title, enacting clause and entire bill
15 and insert

16 "An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries;
17 designating certain highways, bridges and an
18 interchange; requiring placement of markers;
19 providing for codification; and declaring an
20 emergency.

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

22 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.18 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 115 between the junctions of State
2 Highway 49 and State Highway 19 in Comanche and Kiowa Counties shall
3 be designated the "Duty Rowe Scenic Route 115". The Department of
4 Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that
5 section of highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.19 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The four new bridges on State Highway 32 west of the City of
10 Marietta in Love County crossing the Walnut Bayou shall be
11 designated as the "John Adams and Arlie Harrill Memorial Bridges".
12 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
13 markers to be placed upon those bridges bearing those names.

14 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.20 of Title 69, unless
16 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 The bridge on State Highway 62 south of Haskell, Oklahoma, shall
18 be designated the "Private First Class Cody Montana Carver, U.S.
19 Army 3rd Infantry Division Memorial Bridge". The Department of
20 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
21 upon the bridge bearing that name.

22 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
23 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.21 of Title 69, unless
24 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 64 between Muskogee and Keefeton
2 shall be designated the "Representative Jim L. Barker, Speaker of
3 the Oklahoma House of Representatives Memorial Highway". The
4 Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers
5 to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.22 of Title 69, unless
8 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of State Highway 9 from Skagg City Road east to the
10 intersection of State Highway 9-A in Pottawatomie County shall be
11 designated the "U.S. Army Staff Sergeant Ruben Rivers Highway". SSG
12 Ruben Rivers was killed in action during World War II on November
13 19, 1944. He was posthumously awarded the Medal of Honor for his
14 heroic efforts as a member of the 761st Tank Battalion, the first
15 African-American armored unit to serve in combat. In addition to
16 the Medal of Honor, Staff Sergeant Rivers was awarded the Silver
17 Star for previous action with his battalion. The Department of
18 Transportation shall cause suitable markers to be placed upon that
19 section of highway bearing that name.

20 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.23 of Title 69, unless
22 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

23 The section of Interstate 35 from State Highway 64 (Fir Street)
24 south to State Highway 51 shall be designated the "SPC Ross Hunter

1 Duncan Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation shall
2 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing
3 that name.

4 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
5 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.24 of Title 69, unless
6 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

7 The section of State Highway 105 from I-35 east to the Lincoln
8 County line shall be designated the "OHP Lt. J.C. Burris Memorial
9 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
10 permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing that name.

11 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.25 of Title 69, unless
13 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 The interchange of Interstate 235 and North 36th street in
15 Oklahoma City, Oklahoma, shall be designated the "Zach D. Taylor,
16 Jr. Memorial Interchange". The Department of Transportation shall
17 cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge
18 bearing that name.

19 SECTION 9. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
20 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
21 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
22 be in full force from and after its passage and approval."
